



Registration 2026 - 2027 PROGRAM OFFERINGS

Younger Preschool Program (Waitlist) Tuesday and Thursday

9:00 AM – 12:30 PM

Our Younger Preschool program is designed for children ages 2.5 (by September 1) through 3.5. This program provides a warm, nurturing environment where children can begin to feel comfortable and confident outside of their home setting. The focus is on socialization and early independence, including building friendships, exploring new materials, following simple routines and directions, and learning to share and collaborate with peers. Children experience a thoughtful balance of teacher-guided activities and unstructured, play-based learning.

Children enrolled in this program bring their own snack and lunch each day.

Our Older Preschool program is designed for children ages 3.5 to 5 and follows a play-based, center-based approach to learning. This program encourages independence, curiosity, and self-directed learning in a supportive environment that meets children at their individual developmental levels.

Children participate in the Handwriting Without Tears curriculum, as used in Attleboro Public Schools, and explore science and engineering concepts through the Seeds of STEM curriculum.

Participants bring their own snack and lunch each day. Families may also choose to enroll in the extended day program, which runs until 2:00 PM.

4 Day Pre-K (Waitlist)

Monday- Thursday

8:30 AM – 12:30 PM

Our 4-Day Pre-K program is designed for children ages 4 and 5 who are preparing for Kindergarten or who are eligible for Kindergarten but would benefit from an additional year of preschool. Children must be 4 years old by September 1, 2026, to enroll.

This program places a stronger emphasis on academic readiness while remaining developmentally appropriate and play-based. The curriculum supports early literacy, math, and foundational learning skills through structured activities that align with children's expanding focus and stamina. Opportunities for creative expression and social development are woven throughout the day, including art, music, science, drama, fine motor work, and group learning experiences.

Children participate in the Reading Street and Handwriting Without Tears curricula, as used in Attleboro Public Schools, along with the Seeds of STEM curriculum to introduce science and engineering concepts. Participants bring their own snack and lunch each day. Families may also choose to enroll their child in the extended day program, which is dismissed at 2:00 PM.

5 Day Pre-K

Monday- Friday (Waitlist)

8:30 AM – 2:00 PM

Our 5-Day Pre-K program is designed for children ages 4 and 5 who are preparing for Kindergarten or who are eligible for Kindergarten but would benefit from an additional year of preschool. Children must be 4 years old by September 1, 2026, to enroll.

This program places a stronger emphasis on academic readiness while remaining developmentally appropriate and play-based. The curriculum supports early literacy, math, and foundational learning skills through structured activities that align with children's expanding focus and stamina. Opportunities for creative expression and social development are woven throughout the day, including art, music, science, drama, fine motor work, and group learning experiences.

Children participate in the Reading Street and Handwriting Without Tears curricula, as used in Attleboro Public Schools, along with the Seeds of STEM curriculum to introduce science and engineering concepts.

Participants bring their own snack and lunch each day and take part in a 30-minute rest period.

Extended Day

Monday- Friday

12:30 PM – 2:00 PM

Our optional Extended Day program is available to children enrolled in the Older Preschool and 4-Day Pre-K programs. This program includes a 30-minute rest period, outdoor play, and a variety of enrichment activities. Enrollment is limited to 10 children, and drop-in care is not available. Registration is required for the full school year.

Tuition Discount

Families with more than one child enrolled during the same school year are eligible for a 10% sibling discount. The discount is applied to the lesser tuition.

Registration Fee

A non-refundable registration fee of \$75.00 is due at the time of registration to secure your child's placement. This fee covers all children within the same immediate family.

Early Registration

Registration will open for currently enrolled children, their siblings, and children of church members on **Wednesday, January 14, 2026, at 9:00 AM**. Registration will open to the general public on **Saturday, January 31, 2026**.

All registrations must be completed through the Procure Portal at myprocure.com. Enrollment is processed on a first-come, first-served basis. Once your registration is submitted, you will receive an email confirmation from Ms. Lay, at which time the registration fee will be due. Registration fees must be paid within 7 days to secure placement. Payment may be made by check, credit card, or through the Procure portal. If the registration fee is not received within 7 days, the placement will not be secured and may be released.

Tuition Payments

A non-refundable registration fee is due at the time of registration. Tuition is paid in ten monthly installments. **The first payment is due August 1, 2026**. The remaining nine payments are due on the 10th of each month from September through May. *A late fee of \$10.00 will be applied to payments not received on time.* Tuition is due regardless of absences. A 30-day written notice is required for withdrawal.

Early Drop Off

Early drop-off will be offered beginning **Monday, September 14, 2026**, from 8:00 AM to the start of the regular school day, Monday through Friday.

Tuition will be paid in ten equal monthly payments September – June.

One day a week:	\$22.00/month
Two days a week:	\$44.00/month
Three days a week:	\$67.00/month
Four Days a week:	\$88.00/month
Five days a week:	\$112.00/month

We will also offer occasional care, with 24-48 hours' notice, to assist families who may have occasional appointments or need for use for \$10 per day. These requests should be submitted in writing (email is fine).

First Day of School

The first day of school will be Wednesday, September 9, 2026. There will be a family orientation on Tuesday, September 8, 2026, specific times will be shared in August.
