<u>Car Pick Up</u>

We will continue to work out the kinks over the next few weeks and you will find the pick -up line moving faster. Pointers to help us run smoothly:

- Do not begin lining up until 5 minutes prior to dismissal.
 Enrichment's line begins at the end of the 4 Day Pre-K line so please make sure you do not get in line prior to 5 minutes ahead of time or you may end up in the middle of Pre-K dismissal.
- If you arrive early park in a spot and begin forming the line 5 minutes prior to dismissal.

- Please allow for parked vehicles to join the line.
- If you are the first car please pull up ONE CAR LENGTH PAST the dumpster.
- We will only dismiss 3 children at a time.
- If you arrive and the line is at the end of the drive, please make a loop and come back into line safely in the parking lot. Vehicles CAN NOT be hanging off the driveway onto the street. This is a traffic and safety issue.
- PLEASE DO NOT MAKE LEFT HAND TURNS into the parking lot. Go under the train bridge and come back around safely.

<u>Lunch and Snack Reminders</u> Mixed Age, Enrichment and Pre-K Classes

Children in these classes need to bring snack and lunch each day. The snack must be packed separately from their lunches. Please do not pack snack in lunch box with lunch.

A reminder that we must be able to verify that all foods eaten are free of peanuts and tree nuts, if there is no label and we have not received an email regarding the item, the food will not be consumed at school. Please reach out with any questions.
